

# HEALTH SAFETY AND ENVIRONMENT POLICY

## Obligations

Airborne Petroleum Geophysics recognizes its moral and legal responsibility to provide a safe and healthy working environment for its employees, contractors and subcontractors. This responsibility extends to ensuring that the local community and the environment in general are not harmed by our operations.

## Objectives

We will work to:

- meet or when possible exceed legislative and industry safety standards;
- promote compliance with safety requirements;
- improve standards within the airborne geophysics services industry through active support of, and participation in, IAGSA and other industry groups.

## Commitments

We are committed to:

- providing the resources required to implement this policy;
- providing safe equipment and systems of work;
- making HSE management an integral part of our operating procedures;
- continuously monitoring and improving our HSE system;
- having only professional aviators flying in our survey aircraft whenever possible;
- providing support to all employees and contractors;
- training our staff;
- investing in R&D specifically aimed at making the collection of airborne geophysical data safer;
- being receptive and open in communication with customers, employees, contractors and our peers with regard to HSE practices and their improvement;
- empowering any employee to suspend work where necessary to ensure that operations are compliant with our HSE procedures.

## Responsibilities

The responsibility for developing, maintaining and deploying this policy rests with the President of Airborne Petroleum Geophysics.

The responsibility for implementing this policy rests with all group line managers and employees, as well as contractors and subcontractors.

Employees and contractors will be bound to follow all HSE policies and procedures and report known or observed hazards and/or incidents to their immediate supervisor.

## Application of the Policy

This policy is applicable to Airborne Petroleum Geophysics and all of its related companies in their entire operations world wide.
